**PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Hickman County Emergency Food and Shelter Board will meet at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 27, 2020, to take up matters related to Federal funding under phase 37 and the CARES Act made available to Hickman County under the Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP). This is a federal appropriation from Congress to the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program to supplement and expand emergency food and shelter programs. The federal department responsible for this program is the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). All area agencies that provide relief services to area residents and who might be authorized to utilize these funds are encouraged to have someone attend and make a presentation before the board. The award amounts for both phases are as follows:

Phase 37 – \$7,586.00 (Maximum Admin Allowance - \$152)

CARES - \$10,815.00 (Maximum Admin Allowance - \$216)

If your agency provides relief to Hickman Countians in the area of emergency food and shelter, please type up a letter regarding the reason you believe your agency should receive this funding and how much your request is on your agency's letterhead and fax to Hickman County EMA at 931-729-2017 or email to [ema@hickmanco.com](mailto:ema@hickmanco.com). The deadline for the letter is end business on Tuesday, May 26. The meeting will take place at the Emergency Operations Center located at 550 Highway 100 in Centerville, TN and is open to the public.
